She Kills Monsters tells the story of Agnes Evans as she leaves her childhood home in Ohio following the death of her teenage sister, Tilly. When Agnes finds Tilly's Dungeons & Dragons notebook, however, she finds herself catapulted into a journey of discovery and action-packed adventure in the imaginary world that was her sister's refuge. In this high-octane dramatic comedy laden with homicidal fairies, nasty ogres, and 90s pop culture, acclaimed playwright Qui Nguyen explores themes of sexuality and grief through a heart-pounding homage to the geek and warrior within us all.

# A NOTE FROM THE DIRECTOR


Hi, I'm Brenna! (she/they)



# ROLE DESCRIPTIONS

### Agnes Evans - Female, 20s

A high school teacher navigating the loss of her younger sister, Tilly. Described as, "average height, size, and build" and grew up in the average town of Athens, Ohio with average parents.



The geeky younger sister of Agnes. Bullied in life for her weirdness, she reimagines herself in game as the powerful and badass Tillius the Paladin.

### Chuck - Male, Late teens

A member of Tilly's friend group and the Dungeon Master for the game. He helps Agnes throughout the module and introduces her to Tilly's other real life friends.

### Miles - Male, 20s

Agnes' boyfriend of five years. Sweet and well-intentioned but struggles to know how to help Agnes navigate her grief.

### Lilith / Lilly - Female, Late teens

A Demon Queen that resembles a leather-clad dominatrix and is Tilly's girlfriend in the game. Lilith is based on Tilly's high school friend Lilly, who was Tilly's first kiss but is still in the closet.

### Kaliope / Kelly - Female, Late teens

Dark Elf Ranger that is described as looking like a supermodel and is incredibly strong. She is based on Tilly's high school friend Kelly, who is Ronnie's sister, and has a physical disability.

### Orcus / Ronnie - Male, Late teens

A demon overlord of the underworld, Orcus holds onto lost souls and is obsessed with watching television. He is based on one of Tilly's high school friends named Ronnie.



## ROLE DESCRIPTIONS

### Vera - Female, 20s

Agnes's best friend and colleague, a high school guidance counsellor. Sarcastic with a dry wit but cares deeply for her friend. Also plays a *GIANT EYEBALL* (!!) in Tilly's adventure.

### Evil Gabbi & Evil Tina - Female, Late teens

Cheerleader succubi who torment Tilly both in the game and in real life, particularly about her sexuality. They are based on Tilly's high school bullies.

### **Ensemble**



# AUDITION REQUIREMENTS



Auditions will be held in 15 minute blocks on Sunday 16th February (11am - 1pm) and Monday 17th February (6pm - 8pm).

Please prepare the following:

### Monologue:

A 1 - 2 minute monologue from a contemporary play. Can be comedic or dramatic. Please use neutral/your own accent.

### **Special Talent:**

Something special you want to show us! In past auditions, people have whipped out all sorts of tricks from singing songs to making balloon animals to simply showing off how far back they can bend their thumbs. This is just a fun way to get to know a little more about you - so please don't overthink it or stress ©

Auditions will be conducted in 15 minute blocks. You may also be required to 'cold read' a scene from the play which will be presented to you on the day.
